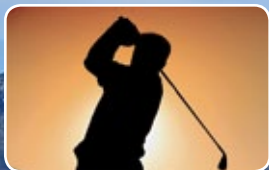

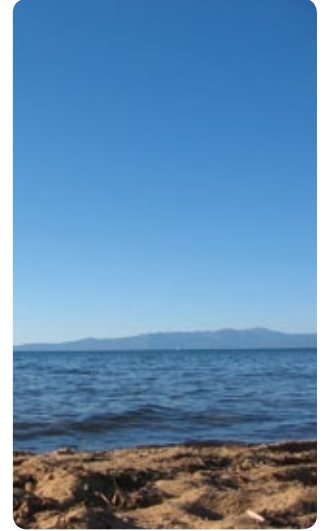

Local Attractions

Skiing

The Ritz-Carlton Highlands, Lake Tahoe ski resort is situated mid-mountain on the Northstar-at-Tahoe ski area and features ski-in, ski-out access with mountain services. An inter-mountain gondola connects guests between the nearby Village at Northstar with The Highlands Village, home of The Ritz-Carlton Highlands, Lake Tahoe. The Village at Northstar centers around an ice-rink with numerous restaurants, bars, galleries and shops throughout. True North, the on-site ski shop in The Ritz-Carlton features premier brands of men's and women's ski and fashion apparel, top performance skis and boots, footwear, extensive eye wear, and accessories for outdoor recreation and relaxation. The Ritz-Carlton ski resort in Lake Tahoe provides ski valet services slopeside and upon check-in for every guest. In the ski valet area, equipment is stored and waiting for the guests. The ski valets will assist each guest with their boots and escort them to the slopeside terrace for ski-in, ski-out access to the Northstar lifts. When guests return to this exceptional ski hotel in Lake Tahoe, the ski valet will retrieve their equipment and store overnight. COA discounted lift tickets rates are: Adult (23 & older) \$57 Young Adult (13-22) \$46 Child (5-12) \$17 Child (4 & under) Free Skiing lessons are also available.

Spa
